Manager's Report – September 2023

General Fund Related

1. Pension Minimum Municipal Obligation - 2024

- Non-Uniformed = \$64,619
- Uniformed = \$37,042
- Total 2024 MMO = \$101,661 Not considering anticipated State Aid reimbursement.

2. Marque' Replacement – Orchard Hills Entrance:

- The brick marque' was replaced. The costs were covered by the driver's insurance policy.
- The borough crew will be reinstalling the letters.

3. SAM Renewal - ARPA Funding

Has been renewed for another year on 8/11/2023. This is funding designated for the police building project.

4. 2023 Golf Tournament Check:

- Presented to the borough on 8/25/2023 in the amount of \$9,000.00, deposited into recreation checking account.
- Grand total contribution through this event (15-year beneficiary) = \$183,563.

5. T-tag Truck Replacement: (Request for Approval)

- 2003 T-tag would be replaced with a new similar type of truck.
- The pricing was received through Sunbury Motors and based on PA Co-stars pricing, meaning that it was bid on a state contract for the entire package.
- Funding would be through the General checking and LST accounts.

Brief Package Summary:

- 2024 Ford F-350 chassis (4x4) SD Regular Cab \$56,740
- Knapheide 9' steel platform body \$11,578
- Boss 9' straight snowplow blade with smart touch blade control system \$8,808
- Boss hopper type salt spreader with cab controls \$10,427.

Estimated total delivered cost = \$87,553.

6. 11th Avenue Property

- The existing tile has been removed around bath/shower walls and a new shower surround, vanity cabinet and top were installed.
- Finished flooring is scheduled to be replaced in the bathroom when the walls are repainted.

7. Zoning Hearing

- A zoning hearing was held on 8/31/2023 to review a request from 47 Jonathan Road.
- The request was a variance for the height of an accessory structure related to a residential use.
- The variance was granted by the zoning hearing board.

2. Water Plant instrumentation upgrade

• The individual turbidity analyzers (HACH - DR 5300's) were replaced with new ones. Parts were not available to service the old units. The replaced units were originally installed in 1992.

3. System Leak

• A leak was found in the system on Helen Street at the Helen Street apartments site. The leak was repaired on August 30th. Estimated water loss per day = 45,000 gallons for at least two-three weeks.

4. Water Allocation Permit Compliance Report

• The yearly required report was submitted on 8/17/2023, accepted by the Department of Environmental Protection DEP), (Harrisburg office).

5. Elevated Water Tank Project Update:

- The tank is entirely painted, inside and out.
- I am hoping to have the final DEP inspection the week of Sept 4th.
- Once inspected and the project completion form is accepted, we will then be able to begin filling the tank with water.
- We are required to perform testing on the water 24 hours after it is filled.
- If the testing is within the acceptable tolerances the tank will be put back into service, the week of September 11th.

6. Sewer connection request

- I have received a sewer request from a homeowner on 11th Avenue due to a failing on lot septic system.
- Our collection system can handle the EDU requested.
- The homeowner must also secure approval from the Eastern Snyder County Regional Authority for the sewage treatment capacity.

1. Investments

2. Borough Crew Ad

- The Ad is finished and has been reviewed by CareerLink. They feel it would be ready to send out.
