

• The Borough Crew will test the leaf pick up equipment in October. The 2023 Fall Leaf Pick Up will begin around the beginning of November depending on the weather and the leaves falling to the ground. Leaves should be raked in piles to the edge of the street, but **not** into the street and **not** near any obstacles. Remember, leaf collection cannot be conducted on days of inclement weather or if the leaves become too wet. **Do not put limbs in the leaf piles.** Limbs can damage and jam our leaf pick up equipment.

Daylight Savings Time ends on **Sunday, November 5, 2023.** Turn your clocks back one hour before you go to bed on **Saturday, November 4, 2023,** and recoup that extra hour of sleep you lost in the spring.
