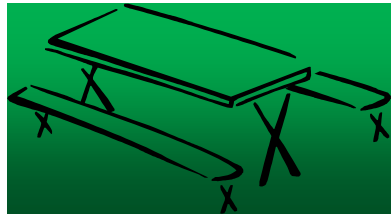

- The Borough Crew will test the leaf pick up equipment in October. The 2024 Fall Leaf Pick Up will begin around the beginning of November. The Borough will conduct the annual leaf collection within a reasonable time after many of the leaves have fallen. The leaves will need to be at the curb line, away from obstacles, and reasonably dry (a period of no rainfall) for leaf collection to be done efficiently. **Do not put limbs in the leaf piles.** Limbs can damage and jam our leaf pick up equipment. Bagged leaves will be picked up on Monday with brush collection.

**Daylight Savings Time** ends on **Sunday, November 3, 2024**. Turn your clocks back one hour before you go to bed on **Saturday, November 2, 2024**, and recoup that extra hour of sleep you lost in the spring.
